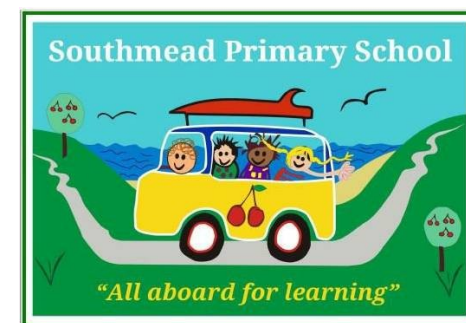
### Drinks
