#### Headteacher News

What weather to end the week on!

I have to say it has been another bright, positive week despite the colder weather setting in. This week has seen our new Positive Behaviour Policy being implemented. Whilst we have only tweaked the previous policy, there is now far more emphasis on rewarding positive behaviours.

Already, we have seen the positive impact of the House-Point system with children really fostering our whole school values - and being keen to earn a non-uniform day at the end of each half-term.

Following on from this, we have worked hard, in discussions with teachers and children, to ensure our behaviour system is fair, consistent and effective. As a result, every children starts the day on 'Green' and can work their way up by making positive behaviour choices, to Gold and Platinum. Poor behaviour choices will result in the children receiving a verbal warning, before moving down to Yellow. However children can earn their way back to Green from here. If poor choices continue, they will move their name to Red. All information will be tracked and parents will be informed of both exemplary and poor behaviours. The children have really responded well to this and they are keen to earn the Gold and Platinum Rewards. They also like the fact that every day is a fresh start - on Green! In December, pupils that have consistently demonstrated Platinum behaviours will be invited to a special 'Time to Shine' assembly with myself and their parents / carers - including drinks and a piece of cake!

Having heard about our Positive Behaviour Policy a Swedish journalist, Helena Soderqvist, asked to interview me and some of our pupils. She was very impressed with our children's attitude and perception of behaviour. Her article will be published in Sweden later next month. We will publish it in our Newsletter in due course.

We have also welcomed numerous visits from prospective parents this week. Having held Reception Tours for 2019 pupils, we have been very impressed with the uptake already. The parents have commented on the welcoming atmosphere, the children's smiles, the standard of work being

produced, the friendly staff and the grounds / facilities we have for the use of their children. This has made us all very proud of Southmead!

Finally, thank you to all of the parents who took part in the Parent Survey during Parent's Evening. We are currently sharing the many positives and working on the areas for development.

I wish you all a great weekend and look forward to seeing you again at the gate, on Monday morning.

### Broken Bones and Sprains

Please inform us if your child has a serious injury e.g. broken a bone or has a severe sprain that the hospital has told them they need to use crutches or a wheelchair for? Please let us know that your child will be school in a cast and / or with crutches or wheelchair, so we can arrange to discuss your child's individual needs whilst they are recovering, and to carry out a risk assessment to ensure that everyone is happy with the arrangements we put in place?

#### Lunch Choices

We would like to ask for your help.

We would like to further improve pupils' lunchtime experience by making it as streamlined as possible. We currently have a few children who order lunch in the morning and then change their minds when they get to the kitchen at lunchtime. This can cause problems as Mr Lymer, our Kitchen Manager cooks to order from the lunches ordered in the morning. Whilst we try to accommodate these changes it can lead to upset and difficulties making sure everyone gets their chosen meal. We know mornings can be hectic, but we would really grateful if you could discuss the day's dinner menu with your child before they come to school in the morning.

#### Nuts

If children are bringing snacks and packed lunches into school, please ensure they are healthy © We kindly request you do not send your child to school with nuts as although for many they are a healthy snack, we have several children with severe allergies to them which could lead to anaphylaxis.

### Birthday Treats

We are happy for children to bring in treats for their class friends when it is their birthday as we want them to celebrate and share in the excitement of their special day. However, we ask that they be given out at the end of the school day and taken home for parents to decide if their child can have them or not. Please be aware treats should not contain nuts and we do have children with various other food allergies as well.

#### **Braunton BMX Track**

There was a proposal for a BMX track that fell by the wayside when the steering group petered out but the funding is still there and a motivated group of local parents have picked it up. If we all give it a push we could hopefully get a significant number of families to take part and get some much needed new free to use community spaces/ equipment.

# Regular Reminders

#### Governors Meetings

The Governors' Meetings are held every half term. These meetings are held in public and as such, those of the school community including parents and carers, are encouraged to attend and sit in the public area to listen to the discussion. Those in the public area cannot participate in the meeting and will be asked to leave if matters of a confidential matter are discussed. If you would be interested in attending a meeting of the Full Governing Body please contact Elaine McIntosh, the Clerk to the Governors, via the school office and she will be delighted to discuss this with you.

#### **Illness**

If your child is poorly and will not be in school, please inform the office as soon as possible. We have a dedicated phone line for absences where you can leave a message even out of office hours. You will need to phone every day your child is absent, unless they have had sickness and diarrhoea when it is Southmead school policy for your child to be absent from school for 48 hours after the last bout of being poorly. This is to reduce the spread of germs to the rest of the children.

#### Attendance and Absence

If your child is going to be absent for any reason during the school day you should collect an absence form from the office. As much notice as possible is required for it to be authorised and returned to the class teacher before the child is taken out of school.

It is important for your child to attend school regularly as it has been proven that children can only do their best and flourish at school if they are present on a regular basis. Children who are late for school and who miss school, often achieve less well than their peers. They also lack self esteem and find it difficult to build and maintain friendships.

The school has a duty to monitor children's attendance. It is a priority issue for Ofsted and it is the school's duty to keep abreast of any circumstances that mean your child is not in school. Any time requested out of school holidays are only authorised if there are exceptional circumstances. If you take your child on holiday in term time, without the prior approval of the school, you are liable for a cash penalty and in extreme cases there are legal implications for parents who do not act within the law

Please notify the school office as soon as possible if any of your contact details change. This includes mobile phone numbers, work numbers and people that you have put as extra contacts who may not be in the area any more.
